- If you are not covered by one of these health plans, you may purchase a vaccination the day of the clinic.
- Homeland Health is Medicare certified and provides vaccinations to Medicare patients. We will bill Medicare or your health plan. Your flu shot is a covered benefit by your Medicare part B or Advantage Health Plan. Bring your Medicare and Supplemental Insurance Card to the clinic.
- Homeland Health is a MN Vaccines for Children Provider and will offer flu vaccine to uninsured children 6 months to 18 years of age for \$20.
